#### PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS PERA: FROM P2,000 TO P8,000

Ang Probinsyano Partylist Rep. Alfred delos Santos has filed a bill that seeks to increase the personal economic relief allowance (PERA) of public school teachers.

The House Bill 6239 will increase teachers' PERA from P2,000 to P8,000.

"The State, through this increase, will be able to demonstrate its full commitment in enhancing and uplifting the living and working conditions of its employees, particularly in the field of education," delos Santos said in his explanatory note.

Delos Santos that the government has to make sure that education gets the highest priority when it comes to budgetary requirements He added that giving teachers ample compensation will help attract and keep top-tier

teaching professionals Delos Santos said funding for the increased allowance will come from the General Appropriations Act.

House Bill 6239 mandates the Department of Education and the Commission on Higher Education, in coordination with the Department of Budget and Management, to promulgate rules and regulations for the desired increase. (FLO-**RENDO CACACTÍN**)

### Cop faces raps over

MANILA - A police officer assigned at the Police Regional Office (PRO)-4A (Calabarzon) is now facing administrative and criminal cases for acts due to his addiction to e-sabong (online cockfighting).

Based on the reports reaching Camp Crame on Thursday, the police officer was identified as Lt. John Kevin Menes, 24, assigned at PNP Drug Enforcement Group - Special Operations Unit - 4 (DEG-SOU4), PRO-4A, who is facing raps for estafa and illegal gambling.

Menes, a graduate of the PNP Academy, was first restricted at the headquarters of the PRO-4A in Laguna over the disappearance of some PHP500.000 in cash allocated to the DEG in Calabaron, which is being used as show money in buy-bust operations and other expenses of the local police anti-drug units.

## **DEPED: EO CREATING NEW TEACHING POSITIONS PENDING AT MALACAÑANG**

An executive order (EO) that will create more teaching positions and allow teachers to have higher salaries is currently pending before the Office of the Executive Secretary, an official of the Department of Education (DepEd) said Wednesday.

DepEd Undersecretary Nepomuceno Malaluan said in a press briefing that once the proposed EO is approved, four more positions such as Teacher 4, 5, 6, and 7 will be created, with corresponding wages of Salary Grade 14, 15, 16, and 17. respectively. "The Secretary actu-

ally presented that to the Cabinet and it was approved by the Cabinet, but its implementation required a close coordination with the DBM (Department of Budget and Management), the Civil Service Commission and the PRC (Professional **Regulation Commis**sion) until we were able to finalize the proposed executive order," he

said. "We are awaiting the approval of this executive order expanding the teacher positions with teacher 4, 5, 6, and 7 and the corresponding

the DepEd also said it is working with the DBM and the CSC in revising the career progression system for public school teachers to help them achieve career and financial stability.

According to Malaluan, some teachers are stuck at Teacher 3 level because opportunities for the succeeding promotion levels are limited.

"Pagkatapos noon (Teacher 3) ay kailangan na ninyong tumalon for promotion to Master Teacher 1, which I think is Salary Grade 18. In between are may mga head teacher positions tayo pero alam natin na very limited ito, kasi head teachers or principal positions are just as many as our schools," he said. (After that, you will

have to jump to Master Teacher 1, which I think is Salary Grade 18. In between, there are head teacher positions but it is very limited because head teachers or principal positions are just as many as our schools.)

The succeeding positions also require higher academic requirements, said Malaluan.

"To be a master teacher is malaki na and academic requirements, at pangalawa ay limited din ang items sa Master Teacher 1 because there is a ratio between your other teachers and the Master Teacher 1 in certain schools. Not all schools actually, as far as I know, have an item for a master teacher, so limited din," he noted.
